Principal's Message

Welcome Back

Welcome back to all of our families for what promises to be an excellent year at The Meadows in 2018. I especially extend a very warm welcome to any new families who have joined us for the first time. I am incredibly proud of the way in which all of our new students have settled in this year. We have formed 11 classes this year with 233 students in total.

Our Kindergarten students have been outstanding in their first 8 school days and the new enrolments across Years 1-6 have also settled in extremely well. This is due to the combined effort of supportive, positive parents and teachers and our caring student body.

An example of the care our students show for one another was exemplified in an email I received from Mr Struyve, Principal of The Hills Sports High School. Mr Struyve kindly let me know that five of his newly-enrolled Year 7 students had assisted another new student who was having quite some difficulty in adjusting to his new surroundings. The five students who were all with us at The Meadows for part or all of their primary school education went out of the way to make the other new student feel comfortable and a lot less anxious in his new surrounds. Our young leaders certainly don't lose these qualities when they enter high school. It was a wonderful email to receive in my first week! Congratulations to our former students Jayden, Ace, Aks, Mayur and Elijah for continuing to strengthen the proud name of The Meadows Public School in our broader community.

Learning for Life

For many years now, The Smith Family has implemented the Learning for Life program in schools. Several families from The Meadows Public School have benefitted greatly from involvement in this program over many years. Learning for Life provides families with opportunities which aim to increase the chance of their children's success at school, TAFE and university.

Learning for Life includes:

- Financial support in the form of a scholarship to help pay for the cost of education. (e.g. school uniform and shoes, text books, excursions)
- Programs that aim to help improve reading, numeracy, leadership, computer and finance skills.
- Access to a local Learning for Life Worker who can link children and families to learning opportunities in their community.

Families who are the holders of a health care or pension card may be eligible for this program. If you are interested in applying for Learning for Life, please collect an information form at the school office and complete the single page application form while you are in the office. All application forms will be forwarded to The Smith Family who will assess each family's eligibility. Please complete your application form at the office by no later than next Friday 16th February.

SCHOOL PROCEDURES

MONEY AT SCHOOL

We impress upon children not to leave money in school bags or classrooms as stolen money creates unhappiness and inconvenience.

PAYMENTS FOR EXCURSIONS ETC.

When students are issued with a note for an excursion, carnivals, and other activities etc. they are to return the permission note & money in a plain envelope or plastic bag from home. Please write your child's name, class and what you are paying for on the envelope. We are happy to receive all your child's payments in one envelope, they do not need to be separate. We are also happy to receive sibling's payments in the same envelope.

If your child has not received a note due to being absent, please see your child's class teacher as they should have any notes that were not initially handed out.

All receipts for payments will be sent to your child's class during the day and handed back to the student the next day.

No change - no change will be given at the front office. As a school we bank daily, consequently we do not have change.

No late payments - please endeavour to make payments before the due date as paying on the due day could result in your child missing an activity. No late payments after the due date will be accepted.

LATE ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL

Please proceed to the office for a late note before going to class.

EARLY LEAVERS

When signing children out early of an afternoon, for appointments etc., parents are asked to do so **before 2:40pm**. Students will not be signed out after this time as this causes disruption to the class teacher who is trying to finalise the day's lessons so students can leave on time.

MESSAGES REGARDING LATE COLLECTION OF STUDENTS

Please phone **before 2:40pm** with any messages if you will be late picking up your child.

SCHOOL CAR PARK
