

#### Principal's Message

#### So great to be back!

This is our first edition of the Meadows Mag this term since the long-awaited resumption of face-to-face teaching and learning. It is just so good to have our 270+ students and 30+ staff back together again in some sort of normality. With 5 weeks remaining, we look forward to finishing the year off in a very busy, productive and positive fashion. Overall, I have been extremely pleased in the way our students have returned to school and quickly readjusted into their new routines after such a long time away. I'm proud of all our students for their resilience and flexibility at this time.

#### **COVID-19 Current Guidelines**

Here's a summary of key organisational structures in place since the post-lockdown return to school:

To keep student groupings as separate as possible we are operating under a 3-Cohort model until the very end of the year with Kindergarten, Stage 1 and Years 3-6 all being kept separate. We have separate playground areas, separate toilets, separate canteen times and different school finish times for each cohort. Added to that, staff are only able to work with one cohort on any given day. Additionally, the following measures are in place:

- Staff continue to wear masks indoors at all times and students are strongly encouraged to wear masks in classrooms and indoor spaces.
- All rooms continue to be very well ventilated using open doors and windows.
- Children with flu-like symptoms are sent home and requested to be covid-tested.
- No parents are allowed onsite during regular school hours except for meetings regarding student wellbeing and for collection of students during extreme weather.
- Unfortunately, parents will be unable to join us for Presentation Day.
- In positive news, parents of Year 6 students will be allowed to attend the Year 6 Graduation Assembly on Wednesday 15th December. More information will be sent to the parents of Year 6 students.

#### **Learning From Home Thank You**

A BIG thank you to all families who were able to support their children during the period of learning from home (LFH). Here's a summary of the key data for the LFH experience for TMPS:

- 58 face-to-face teaching days were missed for Kindergarten and Year 1.
- 63 face-to-face teaching days were missed for Years 2-6
- Overall 184 students out of 275 completed sufficient online work (Seesaw or Google Classroom) during home learning.
- 58 students received booklets, the majority of which have not been returned or only partially returned.
- 33 students were accessing online work, but submission of work was not sufficient.

#### **Semester 2 Reports**

Our Semester 2 Reports will be issued slightly earlier than normal on Monday, 29th November. These reports will strictly focus on the learning experiences offered to your children and their response to them during the Learning from Home period. Some key features of the reports are as follows:

- · The reports will be titled Learning from Home Reports
- In line with Department of Education considerations, the reports will not include any grading of student performance in Key Learning Areas. Therefore, no Outstanding, High, Sound, Basic or Limited grades will be provided.
- The reports will include a comment for each Key Learning Area summarising the types of learning provided during learning from home.
- An Effort rating will be provided for English and Maths based on a balance of the quality and quantity of tasks completed.
- A General comment will be provided, containing strengths and areas for improvement for English and Maths and information regarding overall commitment to learning from home.
- An overall effort grade, Commitment to Learning from Home, will also be provided.
- Attendance will be reported on for the time back at school in Term 4.

#### Staffing News

We have had considerable staffing movement last term and in these past few weeks. Our wonderful Instructional Leader since 2017, Jasmin Choy has been successful in gaining a promotion to a new state-wide position: 'Primary Mathematics Lead Specialist.'

Jasmin will still be based at our school from time to time to trial new strategies. Miss Choy has been an amazing contributor to the staff and students of The Meadows Public School. Her leadership of staff professional learning has been nothing short of exceptional. We wish Jasmin every success in her new, richly deserved role.

The Instructional Leader position held by Miss Choy has been phased out and replaced by a new position: "Assistant Principal (Curriculum & Instruction)". Mrs Katherine McKnight has been successfully appointed to this position for 2022. We look forward to Katherine's leadership of teacher professional learning from the beginning of the new school year.

Our teaching staff will also be affected by change heading into 2022. Our current Kindergarten teacher, Miss Stacey Sammut has been permanently appointed to Northbourne PS. Secondly, our current Stage 1 teacher, Miss Hayley Cassel has received a temporary one-year appointment to Thurgoona PS near Albury. Finally, our current Assistant Principal and 3-6P teacher, Mrs Pho Hanson has received a temporary one-year appointment to Claymore PS. We wish all three teachers the very best for a smooth transition into their new roles and thank each of them for their most positive contribution to our school community.

#### 2022 Planning

To assist the school in planning for 2022, please inform the school as soon as possible if you are moving out of the area, especially if your children are starting a new school next year. There is a form on page 5 of this newsletter that can be completed and returned to the school. There is no need to complete the form if your child is in Year 6 and attending High School in 2022. Additionally, if you have a child ready to start school in Kindergarten next year and you haven't yet completed enrolment, please do so as soon as possible. We have over 40 enrolments now and would love to hit the magic 50 mark for the second year in a row!
