Deadly Ed and his crew facilitated student experiences in a range of activities including dance and spear throwing. Members of our local community also conducted story telling sessions during recess and lunch breaks for all our students to participate in. The day supports ongoing classroom activities to embed indigenous histories and cultures into our daily lives. Thank you to the P&C for holding a BBQ to acknowledge the significance of the day.

#### **Education Week**

Education Week 2023 will be held from July 31st to August 4th 2023 (Week 3, Term 3). This year's theme is 175 years of public education in NSW and focuses on learning from our past, celebrating our achievements and embracing the future with confidence. 
