In additional staffing news, due to family commitments. our Assistant Principal (Curriculum and Instruction), Mrs Katherine McKnight, will be stepping down momentarily from her role at Meadows for the 2024 school year. Mrs McKnight will be teaching a class at Caddies Creek Public School next year

Bike Safety - Helmets

We have a very active group of 20-30 students who use bicycles or scooters to travel to and from school each day. It is incredibly important that parents and carers of these students have regular discussions with their children about road sense and safe riding behaviour. I have received one report of a student involved in taking a considerable risk whilst riding a bike, ignoring a traffic signal at a set of traffic lights. In addition to this, the MAJORITY of our students riding bikes and scooters have not been wearing helmets whilst riding. The parents and carers of these students were issued letters last week regarding this and most students and families have responded very positively to my request. Thank you!



Bicycle riders must wear an approved helmet securely fitted and fastened. This includes children on bikes with training wheels and any child being carried as a passenger or in a bicycle trailer.

Research shows helmets can reduce serious head injuries by about 70% and reduce fatal head injuries by 65%.

High School Orientation

Best wishes to all of our Year 6 students who will attend High School Orientation on Tuesday 28th November. We know you will enjoy the experience and you will be ready when you become Year 7 students next February!

Student Leadership Process

It's almost that time of the year when we are selecting our student leadership team for 2024.

Our current Year 5 cohort is significantly larger than the outgoing Year 6 cohort so we may increase our leadership team accordingly, from 4 to 6 students. This would comprise a school captain, a vice-captain and up to 4 prefects.

Next week, I will address all of our current Year 5 students about these leadership opportunities, and I expect many students to nominate for a position. Those who nominate will bring home application forms to be completed as a starting point to this process. We will hold elections for student leaders on Friday 8th December with the new leadership team being announced at the Years 3-6 Presentation Day Assembly on Wednesday 13th December.

As of today, we have 58 Kindergarten enrolments for 2024. This is a record number in my time as Principal for this stage of Term 4. Our anticipated enrolment number for 2024 across K-6 is approximately 338. This number would allow 15 classes next year compared to the 14 we currently hold.
