

Attendance News!

In line, on time, at 10 to 9!





We do EVERYTHING at The Meadows to encourage positive levels of student attendance. In 2024 and again so far in 2025, our school's attendance rate is slightly above the NSW state average and also above the average for our local Bungarribee network of schools! However, despite these promising results, there's always room for improvement.

We have a range of incentives to inspire excellent levels of attendance. One of these is the awarding of a \$5 Canteen Voucher to any student who achieves perfect attendance across a term. These vouchers are then collected after use and used as tickets in a draw for a \$200 gift voucher at the very end of the year! The more perfect terms a child has, the more chances they will have of winning such an exclusive reward!

As of the time of writing on Wednesday 4th June, we still have 83 wonderful students across K-6 who have maintained PERFECT attendance across the first 6 weeks of Term 2 with ZERO absences and ZERO late days! Congratulations to all! Keep it up! Who can stay 'perfect' until the end of this term and beyond?

A second incentive system we've had in place for a number of years has been our Best Class Attendance Prize. Taking into account whole days of absence as well as late days, a Pizza Party is awarded each term to the class with the highest score.



Kindy Speech and Language Screeners
